London Loader Training - What Are Included In A Loader Training Program? - Any individual who wants to operate a lift truck must take a Loader Training program to be able to become a certified forklift truck operator. There are various ways to obtain forklift training. Programs are provided through workforce training agencies, company forklift certification programs, and approved video and online programs. The cost could be minimal (or without charge) when offered through employment agencies or by occupational safety officers on job sites.

In nearly all countries, forklift operators are needed to be above the age of 18 years old. Local industry bodies together with local and federal authorities can approve the Loader Training courses. They require that operators obtain lift truck certification prior to operating a forklift machinery. A certificate is valid for four years in nearly all areas. Companies which hire employees to drive forklift trucks could face serious liability issues if operators fail to keep this certificate up to date.

The untrained forklift operator is more at risk to cause damage or injuries due to improper operation of the forklift. Thus, safety training programs will comprise correct techniques for driving and loading. Workers should pass a written exam in order to be certified. A company would normally designate a supervisor in order to provide hands-on training to new workers. A licensed supervisor should have extensive training in lift truck safety and be trained as a trainer.
